BOSNIA&HERZEGOVINA AGENCY FOR EDUCATION AND PROFESSIONAL TRAINING

Being one of 73 members of INTERPA, Bosnia&Herzegovina Agency for Education and Professional Training was established in 2008 and it is the only state level (as opposed to the entity level) police academy in Bosnia and Herzegovina. There are two levels of training process – one for police officers and the other for junior inspectors. Since July 2020, we moved to a new location, into a brand new facility expanding over ca. 45.000 m², which includes modern classrooms, sleeping accommodation for 300 cadets, a gym and a shooting range, a martial arts training facility, a library, sports halls, a test drive track etc.

Other than conducting basic training for police officers, the Agency is also in charge of specialized training with continuous cooperation with international organizations in order to keep up with the world's best practices and standards in the field of police training.

As for the Covid-19 pandemic, we have taken all appropriate preventive measures to assure that all employees and cadets follow the Recommendations of the WHO and the training process is held in accordance with the health regulations.
