Justice and equality - Honesty and integrity - Respect for rights and freedoms - Affiliation and fidelity.



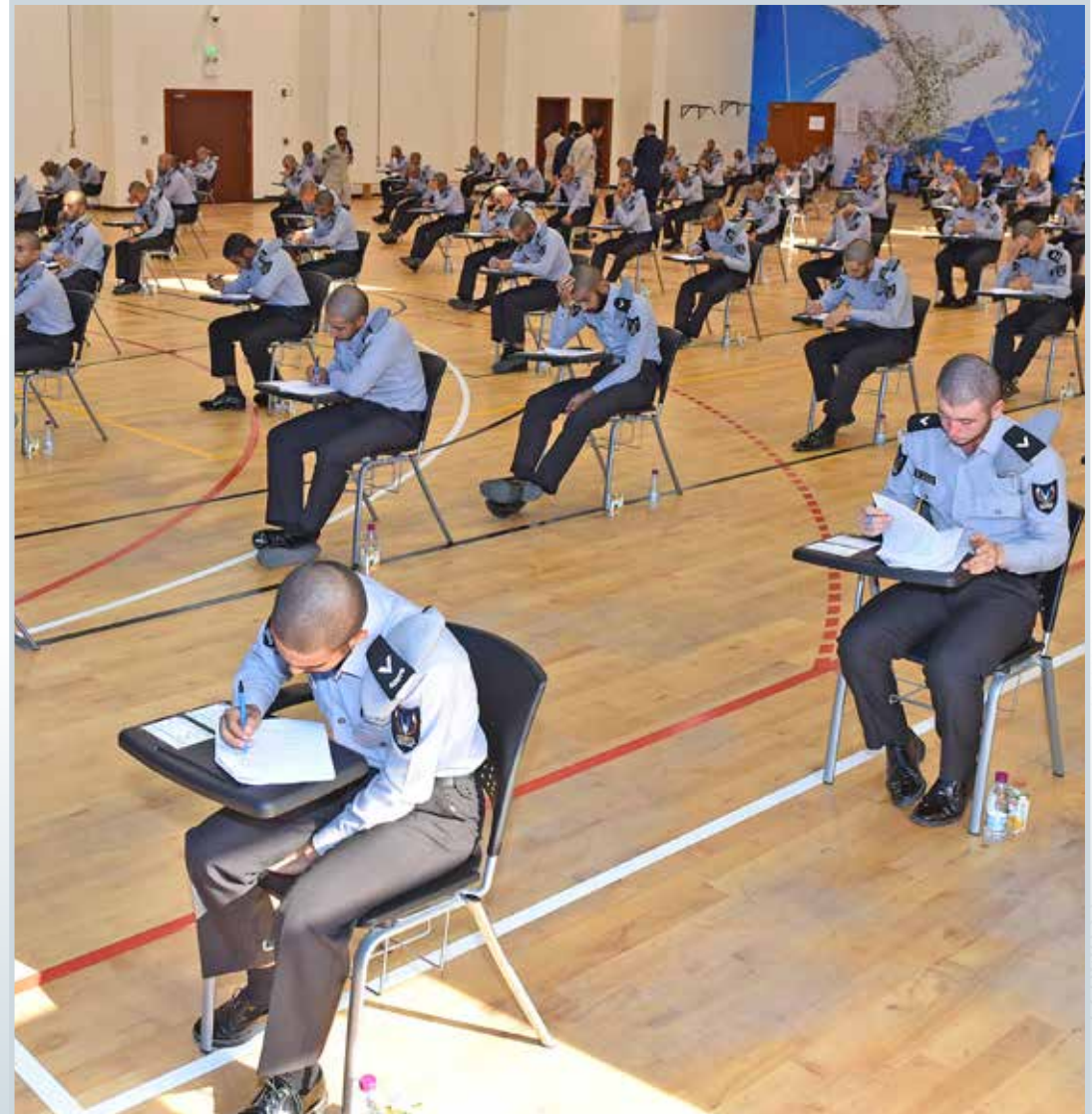
Objectives

The Mandatory Qualifying Course for University Graduates

The Police College executes a mandatory qualifying course for civilian university graduates to provide students with military, legal and security knowledge qualifying them for their future military career as officers in the Qatari Police Forces, who are able to perform their duties effectively to contribute in the security of the motherland.

What distinguishes the Police College?

1 - Training cadets in the English language at Manchester Metropolitan University in the UK

The Police College Cadets join Manchester Metropolitan University UK during the summer vacations to practice English during six weeks to improve their performance in the four basic skills (speaking, reading, listening, writing) they have previously studied at the Police College.

2 - Summer practical training program with MOI security departments

During the summer, the Police College organizes a practical training for its cadets with the security departments of the Ministry of Interior. This program, includes 156 training hours and aim to improve the cadets' skills and give them the opportunity to put their theoretical studies into practice.

3 - Debate, legal clinic and crime scene courses

Debate course

The Police College provides in collaboration with Qatar Debate, a member of Qatar Foundation, a debate course. This course is executed during the fifth term and was successful among students, therefore the college decided to teach it in the following terms.

The Legal Clinic course:

The concept of legal clinic is a new advanced idea practiced in several law colleges around the world. It plays an important role in the field of legal education and serving of the community. The legal clinic also aims to provide the students with practical experience before their graduation and their entry to the work market.

Crime scene course

This course deals with practical and field application of the different crime scene sections and the role of forensics in the crime scene through a living environment that simulates the reality.

Mock simulation course

In order to impart to the study courses a practical character and move from theory to practice, the mock simulation course comes as a practical model for the management of investigation tasks of the crime facts in a training environment, which simulates the reality.

4 - Development of the sense of security

The sense of security is predicting the risk and its sources and dealing with it before it occurs or arresting the perpetrators after the crime. For that reason, the Police College attached great importance to this concept since its creation and endeavored to develop it in its students and staff so that they become highly aware of it.

5 - General Lectures

The Police College delivers general lectures to its cadets almost on a weekly basis. The aim of these lectures is to inform the cadets of the important issues in the country, broaden their knowledge and strengthen their affiliation to the homeland.

6. Scientific and Community participations

a) Scientific participations

The Police College encourages its cadets and staff to participate in the different scientific events in the country, especially those organized by the College and the other MOI departments.

b) Community participations
